## Director's Notes

- Financial Officer - Matt Saitta

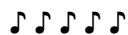

I'd like to take this opportunity to thank everyone that helped. An event like this can't be done by one person and I appreciate your support:

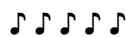
- Art Horn, Frank Knickerbocker and their solicitations team who went out and found all the items that we bid on, raffled off or sold in balloons.

**Adam Settle** will attend West Virginia University where he plans to study criminal justice and minor in music.

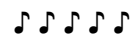
**Catie Smith** plans to attend Christopher Newport University and major in history and secondary education with a minor in leadership.

**Kelly Jean Williams** plans on attending James Madison University and major in Speech Pathology.

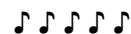

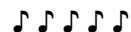


## **HOSPITALITY COMMITTEE**

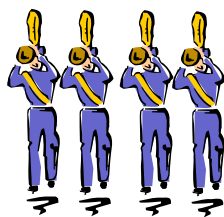
## **STUDENT ACCOUNTS**

Upcoming events:

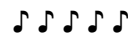

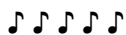
## NEWS FROM THE CONCESSIONS CREW

summer and we'll see you in the stand in the fall.

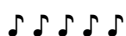

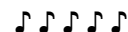


## VIRGINIA DINER GOURMET NUTS AND CHOCOLATES

Look for the Virginia Diner Gourmet Nuts and Chocolates fundraiser materials at the end of Marching Spartans summer camp/1<sup>st</sup> week of

school in September. The fundraiser will run for 2-3 weeks. This is how it works: Sell to family, friends, neighbors, colleagues, etc. or buy just for yourself. The quality of the gourmet food is wonderful! **50% of your student's sales will be put into your student's band account, to spend on band expenses as you see fit.** It's as easy -- and profitable -- for you as that. It's "free money" for your student's account if you take advantage of this fundraiser. It's a great way to pay for your spring trip -- or at least your \$150 of spending money for your trip!

In addition to the September fundraiser, Virginia Diner will also accept online orders all year long, albeit with a slightly lower percentage of the sales credited to your band account.



## BAND AWARDS

Marching band and color guard band students qualify for varsity letters, just like other varsity sports. Varsity Letters are awarded to members of the program when the student fulfills the necessary requirements within **one** school year. Gold bars are awarded for the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> year the student earns a letter. This year we awarded 30 varsity letters to the students. Last year the students earned 31 varsity letters. Congratulations to these students!

### *Criteria for Earning a Band/Color Guard Letter*

1. To earn a Band Letter, you must fulfill 4 out of 5 requirements on the awards form:

a. Be a member in good standing of the Marching Spartans.

b. Have perfect attendance at all rehearsals and performances. Perfect attendance means perfect attendance. Even if absences are excused, they still disqualify you for this criterion.

c. Audition for All-District Band. (You don't have to make it; just be brave enough to audition.)

d. Participate for the full day on Tag Day.

e. Participate in Solo and Ensemble Festival.

**2. To earn a Color Guard Letter, you must fulfill 3 out of 4 of the following criteria:**

a. Be a member in good standing of Fall Guard during Marching Band season (mark "Marching Band" on awards form).

b. Be a member in good standing of Indoor Guard.

c. Have perfect attendance at all Band and Guard activities as defined in 1b above.

d. Participate for the full day on Tag Day.

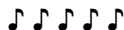
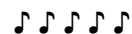
